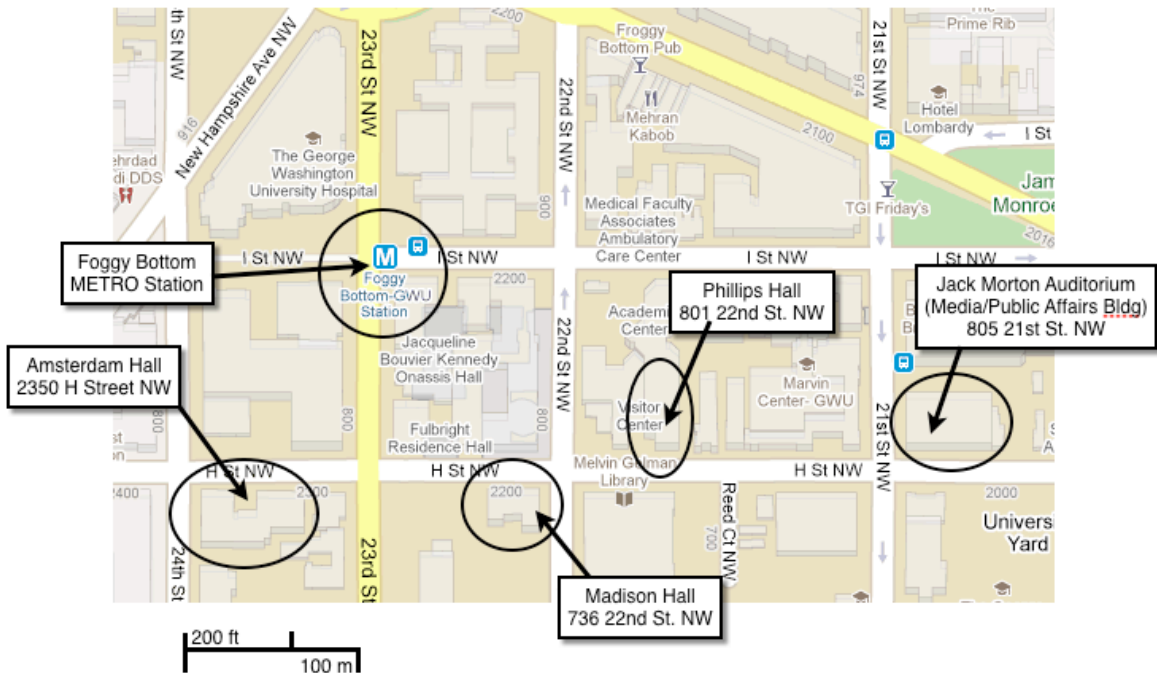


## ICAD 2010 George Washington University Campus Housing Information



ICAD 2010 attendees who have registered in advance online for one of the GWU campus housing packages will be staying in **Madison Hall at 736 22nd St. NW.**

**(Campus housing is not available for attendees who plan to register on site.)**

When you arrive, you must first check in at the **Summer Guest Services Office in Amsterdam Hall, 2350 H Street NW** to be issued an access card and key(s) for your room.

**Check-in is after 3:00 pm** (no earlier) on **8 June** and **10 June**, so plan accordingly.

**All summer guests are responsible for returning their access card and key(s) upon check out to avoid replacement fees.**

**Check-out is scheduled for no later than 11:00 A.M. daily.** Summer guests will also check out at the Summer Guest Services Office at Amsterdam Hall, 2350 H Street NW

The map above shows the location of Amsterdam Hall in relation to the **Foggy Bottom METRO Station**. Also shown are **Madison Hall, Phillips Hall,** and the **Jack Morton Auditorium**.

Pre-conference activities (the ICAD Think Tank and the Sonification Workshop/Hack Day) will take place in **Phillips Hall** in **Room B120** on June 9 and 10.
